


Project lifecycle amendment

- The technical community identified our project lifecycle as an area we could improve through simplification
 - Simplify the definition of project to one type (previously four)
 - New proposal: https://wiki.opnfv.org/project_lifecycle
 - Allowing common themes to be addressed in one project
 - Additionally simplifying project lifecycle stages of promotion
- Additional changes required on TSC membership for "top level" projects. (discussed later)

Project lifecycle amendment

- As the most mature lifecycle state of the project is proposed to be "integration", the bylaws reference to "top level" projects has been amended.
- The section relating to TSC membership for "(i) a project lead from each top level project"
- The intention is to propose an election amongst "integration" project leaders to a pre-defined number or TSC seats.
 - The number will be established via a TSC proposal to the board when needed.



Brahmaputra update

- Brahmaputra passed Milestone C on time.
 - The TSC acknowledged successful completion on Sept-29th
- Arno SR1 shipped October 1st
 - Container iterative bug fixes on Arno
 - Significant work done on the LF lab infrastructure
 - Enabling bare-metal and virtual deployment



Brahmaputra status update

- Brahmaputra timing and schedule on-track.
 - Planned release date: 02-Feb-2016



- Brahmaputra passed Milestone C
 - Milestone reporting was excellent huge community effort in Jira
 - Challenges now to execute on sprint (timeline) targets
 - Acknowledged that many unknown issues and constraints exist.



Milestone C stats and facts

- 38 projects reported status with Jira plans for Brahmaputra.
 - One project withdrew from the process
- Based on required scope the following project reported Yellow status:
 - Fuel: conflicts with SR1. jira planned to be done Oct 16, large number of incoming dependencies
 - JOID: dependencies still coming in, awaiting Genesis final requirements
 - Pharos: capacity req's not understood, add resources or reduce scope
 - Policy Test: new project in startup mode, still reviewing jira
